Also, many high-profile activities took place, for example, the Symposium on Oral Health Care and The Role of Primary Health Services in the Americas, held on Saturday March 28th, when the Chilean Ministry of Health's Head of the Oral Health Department, Dr. Elizabeth Lopez, acted as moderator with the participation of international panel members such as Dr. Conrado Barzaga (USA), international leader in public health; Dr. Saskia Estupiñán (Ecuador), Head Advisor and Coordinator for the Special Programs Team and Health for Vulnerable Populations at the Pan-American Health Organization, and Dr. Noemi Bordoni (Argentina), Director of the Universidad de Buenos Aires Public Health Research Institute.
